

### Remembering our Friend, Gary Dumas

Born in San Antonio, Texas, Gary grew up one of four kids in a family focused on construction, engineering and oil exploration, eventually living in both Michigan's upper peninsula and Minnesota.

He enlisted in the US Navy in August 1962 serving as a Hospital Corpsman, eventually retiring as a Chief Petty Officer. During which time he would be posted to duty stations in San Diego, California; Jacksonville, Florida; Portsmouth, Virginia; Memphis, Tennessee; Kingsville, Texas; Guam, Marianas Islands; and aboard the ships USS Navarro (APA-215); USS Princeton (LPH-5); and USS Acadia (AD-42).

During his Navy career he deployed to Vietnam in 1968, conducted the post-mission physicals on the Apollo 10 crew in 1969, and supported the mass evacuation operations in the wake of the collapse of the Republic of Vietnam in 1975.

By the end of his Navy career in 1982, he had earned the Navy Achievement medal, Navy Unit Commendation medal, the Meritorious Unit Commendation, the Good Conduct medal (four awards), the National Defense Service medal, Vietnam Service medal (four awards) the Humanitarian Service medal, and the Republic of Vietnam Campaign medal.

Following the Navy, Gary went to work in the pharmacy at Mercy hospital in Hillcrest while also attending National University where he later received a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration.

The next chapter of his career started in 1985 when he became a pharmaceutical representative, with emphasis on oncology and HIV medications while serving hospitals and medical offices throughout Southern California.

In the late 1990's Gary finally chose to pursue his interest in classic cars, specifically a 1956 Ford Thunderbird that he bought to maintain, drive, and show. In addition to participating in parades and winning numerous awards, he would also serve as the President of The Classic Thunderbirds of San Diego County for two years. Though he was less active in club activities in the later years, he stayed involved with the club until recently.

Gary passed away in his Poway home on Thursday the 17th, he was 80 years old. He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Cheryl, and their two children, three grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.





David Durrill's Thunderbird restoration is coming along nicely. It is mostly painted and starting to be put back together. The fun part is getting the new weather seals/rubber installed so the doors and trunk will close easily with the proper gaps. He hopes to have it back on the road soon!




